- Tack cleaning kit to include Saddle soap, cloths/sponges
- Hard Feed (closed bucket) & Hay (at least half a bale per day)
- X2 Water buckets
- Bedding no paper bedding shavings/straw please.
- Barrow, Shovel/Fork & Brush.
- Don't panic if you forget anything on the Sunday lots of people around to help you settle in !!!

West Waterford Pony Club Camp Important Stable Area Information

You are responsible for ensuring;

- Your pony's stable is closed and secured at all times using the chain supplied. The chain must be secured as demonstrated by your camp supervisor.
- You make regular checks to ensure that your stable is secure, please report any problems to your camp supervisor.
- Your pony has a Clean Bed and <u>sufficient Feed and</u>
 <u>Water throughout the day</u>.
- You store all hard feed in a secure, lidded container in the Designated Secure Area.
- You keep the area around your stable clean and tidy.
- That before you leave each evening, you leave hay and water in front of your pony's stable for morning feeds. Hard feed must be left in a labeled bucket in the Designated Secure Area.
