There are 3 stages - Dressage : Showjumping : Cross Country

Eventing is one of the Olympic equestrian sports. It consists of three disciplines – dressage, show jumping and cross country. The dressage phase is always completed first, followed by show jumping and cross country. The same horse and rider combination must complete all three phases, Individual clubs run eventing competitions in the summer.

Anyone can attend as long as you meet the criteria in the guide to competitions info below. You book in and compete in the qualifiers as an individual. See dates of competitions below. You must compete in at least 2 of the qualifiers with two clear XC rounds to qualify for the National Championships in Tattersalls on 24th & 25th August 2024. This is a fantastic individual or team event. You will require stabling & accommodation if you intend staying overnight - these get booked up early. *You will be notified via WhatsApp when entries are open for the championships.*
